OVERLY by East Coast @ Los Angeles County Museum of Art

As part of LACMA's ambitious transformation to unify its buildings and outdoor spaces, OVERLY by East Coast played a key role in delivering custom architectural metalwork solutions. The project involved engineering and manufacturing specialized flush-seam metal roofing, sunshades, and rainscreen panels. Crafted from 18-gauge painted sheet aluminum and 1/8-inch post-painted plate aluminum, these components were integral to several iconic structures on the campus. Highlights include the Resnick Pavilion's distinctive cantilevered louvers, the Broad Contemporary Art Museum (BCAM), and two pedestrian canopies. OVERLY by East Coast's contributions helped realize a cohesive architectural vision, blending form and function across LACMA's revitalized campus.
