



OVERLY by East Coast @ The Milwaukee Art Museum Addition

Located on the shore of Lake Michigan, the 125,000 sq. ft. addition to the Milwaukee Art Museum has received several coveted architectural awards since it first opened in October of 2001. The building's stunning design by world-renowned architect/engineer Santiago Calatrava is complemented by its excellent construction. It features sweeping architectural finishes like free-form concrete buttresses and white metal exteriors, including the roof. All three of Overly by East Coast's roofing systems, Batten, Bermuda, and Evolution, as well as some flatlock, were utilized on this project. Also, portions of the pavilion walls, the Brise Soleil, and the cable walkway that links the museum with Milwaukee's downtown district are made from Overly by East Coast's custom-profile wall panel system.
